 Review and discussion of the annual scope of work for online advertising from USDM – Leah Woolford with USDM discussed the scope of work for the 2013-2014 fiscal year which included the core service budget and the online media campaign.

 Review and discussion of the annual scope of work for traditional advertising from Bohan and scope of work for Majority Opinion Research – Ben Hale with Bohan discussed the scope of work for the 2013-2014 fiscal year.

Marketing Manager Carr discussed the scope of work with Majority Opinion Research and briefly highlighted the five studies that would be completed.

3. Review and discussion of possible amendments to the beer ordinance — City Attorney Gass discussed a possible amendment to help make the beer ordinance more consistent with state law by mitigating different rules between liquor by the drink and beer. Mr. Gass also discussed options for disbursing liquor funds to the Pigeon Forge Schools and it was proposed to adopt an ordinance to create a committee to oversee the disbursement of funds received.
