## MINUTES OF CITY COMMISSION WORK SESSION TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2012, 4:00 P.M. CITY HALL, PIGEON FORGE, TENNESSEE

Present were Mayor Wear, Vice Mayor McClure, Commissioner Brackins, Commissioner Reagan, Commissioner Robinson, City Manager Teaster, City Attorney Gass, and interested parties.

Items discussed were as follows.

- 1. **Review and discussion of an updated storm water ordinance.** Brandon Williams presented information on the updates to the ordinance. Mr. Williams stated there were about ten changes to the ordinance. The changes are based upon EPA and TDEC requirements. Mr. Williams stated that the main change is that more samples will need to be taken.
- 2. Review and discussion of Ordinance No. 947 regarding special events. David Taylor reviewed the ordinance with the council. Mr. Taylor stated that the ordinance provides a formal process for the Planning Commission to follow regarding special events. Mr. Taylor stated that language was added to address the rotary tent and car shows. Mr. Taylor explained how the process works for special events. Mr. Taylor answered questions from the Public and Commissioners regarding special events associated with the City sponsored special event and the definition of a special event.
- 3. **Review and discussion of car shows.** The City Manager provided an overview of what was discussed at the first car show committee. Ms. Teaster stated that the main issue discussed was traffic, vending in the State Right-of-Way, and porta potties. Ms Teaster asked members of the committee to provide further detail of what the discussion was regarding each issue. Bill Howell provided an overview; Bob Barnes provided information as well as Ken Maples. Ms. Teaster also asked the car show sponsors to speak. Dan Draper thanked the city and discussed how the move to Splash Country is working. Charlie Cobble discussed the F-100 show and Rod Milligan discussed the Grand Run. Discussion was also brought up about the possibility of having a car coral and getting vehicles for sale off of the State Right-of-Way. An update and price was provided on porta potties. The location of the porta potties was discussed and staff is working on the locations. The car show committee will meet again in the future.
- 4. **Review and discussion of The Island intersection design.** Bob Bowers from Wilbur Smith provided an update and presented a drawing of how the intersection at Smoky Drive and the parkway will look. Mr. Bowers answered questions from the public and Commissioners regarding the design. Mr.

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Bowers also reviewed the future Jake Thomas Road and Veterans Boulevard intersection. Mr. Bowers stated and new traffic study will need to be completed and a concept plan on the road.

5. **Other.** The City Manager stated that the Jake Thomas Road bid opening will be tomorrow at 4pm in the council room. Ms. Teaster stated the new garbage truck will be delivered tomorrow. Ms. Teaster asked the Commission to check their calendars for September 19<sup>th</sup> to sign the steel at the events center and will last from 12-4pm.
