MINUTES OF CITY COMMISSION MEETING MONDAY, DECEMBER 28 2009, 5:30 P.M. CITY HALL, PIGEON FORGE, TENNESSEE

Mayor Whaley called the meeting to order with the following in attendance: Vice Mayor McClure, Commissioner Brackins, Commissioner Robinson, Commissioner Wear, City Manager Teaster, City Recorder Clabo, City Attorney Gass, members of the press and interested citizens.

Mayor Whaley opened the meeting and Vice Mayor McClure led in the pledge of allegiance.

REGULAR MEETING

The minutes were unanimously approved following motion by Vice Mayor McClure and second to motion by Commissioner Brackins.

The authorization for the payment of bills was presented for approval. Commissioner Robinson asked that language be included in minutes to reflect that City Attorney Gass stated in a previous meeting that when the budget is approved, Bohan is authorized to spend money budgeted. Following request, authorization for the payment of bills was unanimously approved following motion by Commissioner Brackins and second to motion by Vice Mayor McClure.

Approval of the use of the Surface Transportation Program Funds for traffic signalization and road resurfacing was presented for approval. Assistant City Manager Brackins stated that the city requests to use the funds for traffic signalization at the intersection of the Parkway (U.S. 441) and Music Road and the approximate cost is \$200,000. The second project request is for resurfacing of city streets in the amount of \$192,236 for a total of \$392,236. On a motion by Vice Mayor McClure, second by Commissioner Brackins, it was unanimously approved to accept the request as presented.

- 2. Would like to schedule a work session on January 6, 2010 at 1:30 p.m.
