

**MINUTES OF  
CITY COMMISSION MEETING  
MONDAY, JANUARY 25, 2021, 5:30 P.M.  
CITY HALL, PIGEON FORGE, TENNESSEE**

Mayor Wear called the meeting to order with the following in attendance: Vice Mayor McClure, Commissioner Maples, Commissioner Ogle, Commissioner Watts, City Manager Teaster, City Recorder Clabo, City Attorney Rowell and interested citizens.

Mayor Wear opened the meeting and Vice Mayor McClure led in the pledge of allegiance.

**REGULAR MEETING**

The minutes were unanimously approved following motion by Commissioner Watts and second to motion by Vice Mayor McClure.

Mayor Wear asked if there were any comments from citizens.

No comments were received.

The authorization for the payment of bills was presented for approval. On a motion by Vice Mayor McClure, second by Commissioner Ogle, it was unanimously approved to accept the bills as presented.

**Old Business**

There was no old business.

**New Business**

Discussion and consideration of a maintenance agreement with Motorola Solutions for radio tower equipment for the police department was presented for approval as a sole source item. Police Chief Catlett to purchase two mobile radios for the police department utilizing the statewide contract was presented for approval. Police Chief Catlett presented and recommended the purchase in the amount of \$10,267.40. On a motion by Commissioner Maples, second by Commissioner Watts, it was unanimously approved to accept the request as presented.

Discussion and consideration of an amendment to the contract with Gresham Smith for Right-of-Way services for the greenway was presented for approval. Shap Stiles with Gresham Smith presented and recommended the additional services in the amount of \$49,800. On a motion by Vice Mayor McClure, second by Commissioner Maples, it was unanimously approved to accept the agreement as presented.

Manager's report included the following:

1. There will be a public hearing on Ordinance No. 1104 at the regularly scheduled council meeting on February 8, 2021.
2. The city has been awarded a \$2,000,000 grant to be used for the construction of the mass transit building.
3. There has been a preconstruction meeting with TDOT on the construction of the Jake Thomas extension and grubbing will start tomorrow.
4. Would like a mid-year review next week to discuss several items. Looking at February 3, 2021 at 3:30 p.m.

Mayor Wear asked for comments from the board.

Having no comments received, the meeting was duly adjourned at 5:35 p.m.
