

**MINUTES OF
CITY COMMISSION WORK SESSION
WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 3, 2021, 3:30 P.M.
CITY HALL, PIGEON FORGE, TENNESSEE**

Present were Mayor Wear, Vice Mayor McClure, Commissioner Maples, Commissioner Ogle, Commissioner Watts, City Manager Teaster, Assistant City Manager Brackins, City Recorder Clabo, and interested parties.

Items discussed were as follows.

1. **Review and discussion of Patriot Park property boundary and storm water pipe** – Assistant City Manager Brackins along with Eric Kelch discussed the proposal of moving the property line boundary and relocating a storm water pipe. It was noted that piping was estimated to cost \$60,000.

Following discussion, council general agreed have staff work on and bring back to a future meeting.

2. **Review and discussion of grant applications for the fire department** – Fire Chief Watson presented and discussed two grants. The first was in the amount of \$818,115 for the replacement of a fire engine. The second grant would be in the amount of \$45,000 for a washer/dryer unit, a gear dryer and personnel lockers. Both would require a 10 percent local match.

Following discussion, council generally agreed to put on upcoming agenda for consideration.

3. **Review and discussion of city projects** – Assistant City Manager Brackins gave update on various projects including:
 - a. Transit FF&E – need funding for furnishings of new transit building.
 - b. Bridge on Tiger Drive – Discussion of moving for greenway project.
 - c. Impound Lot – There is a growing need to improve lot where impounded vehicles are stored.

Following discussion, no direction was given as this was for informational purposes only.

4. **Other** – Discussion regarding making change to vacation policy.

Following discussion, council generally agreed to put on upcoming agenda for consideration.

After general discussion, the meeting was duly adjourned at 5:35 p.m.
