

**MINUTES OF
CITY COMMISSION WORK SESSION
WEDNESDAY, MAY 5, 2021, 3:30 P.M.
CITY HALL, PIGEON FORGE, TENNESSEE**

Present were Mayor Wear, Vice Mayor McClure, Commissioner Maples, Commissioner Ogle, Commissioner Watts, City Manager Teaster, Assistant Finance Director Baiamonte, City Attorney Rowell, and interested parties.

Items discussed were as follows.

1. **Update on the Goose Gap, Waldens Creek Intersection** – Public Works Director Miller presented and discussed the options available for dealing with traffic at this intersection. The options discussed were a four-way stop, a traffic signal with camera sensor, or a circular intersection. It was recommended that a traffic signal and camera sensor at a cost of approximately \$80,000.00 would be the most effective long-term solution.

Following discussion, council recommended an engineering agreement be ready to presented at the next council meeting.

2. **Review and discussion of Car Shows** – Police Chief Catlett presented and discussed the increase in calls, citations and traffic flow that his department had to deal with during the last car show. He presented recommendations for increasing citation fees and increasing the law enforcement presence using nearby agencies. Comments were received from attendees.

Following lengthy discussion, council recommended forming a car show committee.

3. **Review and discussion of The Tower Shops at Mountain Mile infrastructure** – Developer Dixon Greenwood presented and discussed updates going on with the development's progress and asked for assistance from the city with some infrastructure improvements.

Following discussion, council advised Mr. Greenwood to get with staff to work out specific details.

4. **Other** – City Manager Teaster requested that the board be considering possible appointments to the advisor board and that a change order would be coming on the Joe Ogle property development.

After general discussion, the meeting was duly adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
