

**MINUTES OF  
CITY COMMISSION WORK SESSION  
MONDAY, JUNE 25, 2012, 4:00 P.M.  
CITY HALL, PIGEON FORGE, TENNESSEE**

Present were Mayor Wear, Vice Mayor McClure, Commissioner Brackins, Commissioner Reagan, Commissioner Robinson, City Manager Teaster, City Recorder Clabo, City Attorney Gass, and interested parties.

Items discussed were as follows.

1. **Review and discussion of the next steps for the construction of the new wastewater treatment plant** – Sam Harrison with SSR discussed the technical memorandum dated June 22, 2012. He stated that the proposal allows Pigeon Forge to grow 50 percent of its current size. Commissioner Robinson asked about obtaining a second opinion. Mr. Harrison stated it could be done by peer review. He estimated the cost to be approximately \$40,000 and the process to take about four to six months.

Following discussion, council agreed to look at bidding parts of the plant as alternatives, redesign, rebid, and put on a upcoming agenda for consideration.

After general discussion, the meeting was duly adjourned at 5:20 p.m.
