

**MINUTES OF
SPECIAL CALLED CITY COMMISSION MEETING
MONDAY, JUNE 20, 2022, 5:00 P.M.
CITY HALL, PIGEON FORGE, TENNESSEE**

Mayor Wear called the meeting to order with the following in attendance: Vice Mayor McClure, Commissioner Ogle, Commissioner Watts, Assistant City Manager Brackins, City Recorder Clabo, City Attorney Rowell, and interested citizens. Commissioner Whaley and City Manager Teaster were absent.

Mayor Wear opened the meeting and Vice Mayor McClure led in the pledge of allegiance.

REGULAR MEETING

The minutes were unanimously approved following motion by Vice Mayor McClure and second to motion by Commissioner Ogle.

Mayor Wear asked if there were any comments from citizens.

No comments were received.

Old Business

Ordinance No. 1133 to amend Ordinance No. 1112 annual appropriations for fiscal year 2021-2022 was presented on the second reading. City Recorder Clabo presented. On a motion by Vice Mayor McClure, second by Commissioner Ogle, and with all voting “aye” the motion was approved on the second reading.

Ordinance No. 1134 to adopt the annual budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023 was presented on the second reading. Assistant City Manager Brackins presented and noted that only one additional change was being presented for the budget. Veolia was requesting a change to their scope of work to include line location activities. This will result in an additional cost of \$110,000. Motion was made by Vice Mayor McClure, second by Commissioner Ogle to approve budget. Before the vote, City Recorder Clabo asked for clarification on adopting budget as per first reading or with additional noted requests. Vice Mayor McClure clarified his motion to approve budget and include minimum pay for all city employees to \$15 per hour, approve the proposed accrued sick leave policy, and approve the line location proposal by Veolia. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Ogle, and with all voting “aye” the motion was approved on the second reading.

New Business

There was nothing to report under the Manager’s report.

Mayor Wear asked for comments from the board.

Mayor Wear thanked staff for work on budget.

Having no other comments received, the meeting was duly adjourned at 5:05 p.m.
