

**MINUTES OF
CITY COMMISSION WORK SESSION
WEDNESDAY, JULY 20, 2022, 3:30 P.M.
CITY HALL, PIGEON FORGE, TENNESSEE**

Present were Mayor Wear, Vice Mayor McClure, Commissioner Ogle, Commissioner Watts, City Manager Teaster, Assistant City Manager Brackins, City Recorder Clabo, and interested parties. Commissioner Whaley and City Attorney Rowell were absent.

Items discussed were as follows.

1. **Review and discussion of turf options at Wear Farm Park** – Assistant City Manager Brackins presented and discussed two options being considered for the baseball fields at Wear Farm Park. Option one would utilize synthetic rubber and sand on the fields with an additional cost of \$481,118 while option two would utilize brockfill and sand with an additional cost of \$1,003,844. Funds for option one would come from the City of Pigeon Forge Baseball account while option two funding would need to be discussed further.

Following discussion, council agreed to put on upcoming agenda for discussion and consideration.

2. **Review and discussion of a monument sign for the LeConte Center** – LeConte Center Manager Campbell presented and discussed four RFP's had been submitted for consideration. It was his recommendation to accept proposal from Snyder Signs, Inc. in the amount of \$218,048. The amount budgeted was \$220,000.

Following discussion of proposals submitted, council generally agreed to put on upcoming agenda for discussion and consideration.

After general discussion, the meeting was duly adjourned at 5:00 p.m.
