

**MINUTES OF
CITY COMMISSION WORK SESSION
THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 22, 2016, 3:30 P.M.
CITY HALL, PIGEON FORGE, TENNESSEE**

Present were Mayor Wear, Commissioner Brackins, Commissioner Ogle, City Manager Teaster, Finance Coordinator Baiamonte, City Attorney Gass, and interested parties. Vice Mayor McClure and Commissioner Maples were absent.

Items discussed were as follows.

1. **Review and discussion of the proposed Information Technology office space addition** – Mike Smelcer with SRA was in attendance to discuss a drawing for an IT addition at city hall. He discussed a cost estimate and the different options available for the space between city hall and the police department.

Following discussion, council generally agreed to move project forward and get ready to bid.

2. **Review and discussion of Ordinance No. 1024, an ordinance to add chapter 5”repurified water” to the Pigeon Forge Municipal Code** – Mark Miller presented and discussed ordinance. There were several suggestions to add or remove sections in the ordinance and also to change some of the language.

Following discussion, council generally agreed to have city attorney make necessary changes and put on upcoming agenda.

3. **Other** – John Mayberry and his wife were in attendance to address the commission and ask what can be done to enforce R-1 zoning ordinance regarding overnight rentals.

Following discussion, council generally agreed that violators would continue to be cited daily and the issue would be discussed further after the court date.

After general discussion, the meeting was duly adjourned at 5:00 p.m.
