

**MINUTES OF  
CITY COMMISSION WORK SESSION  
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2021, 5:40 P.M.  
CITY HALL, PIGEON FORGE, TENNESSEE**

Present were Mayor Wear, Vice Mayor McClure, Commissioner Maples, Commissioner Ogle, Commissioner Watts, City Manager Teaster, Assistant City Manager Brackins, City Recorder Clabo, City Attorney Rowell, and interested parties.

Items discussed were as follows.

1. **Review and discussion to purchase a new fire engine for the fire department** – Fire Chief Watson presented and discussed the need for a new fire truck. He discussed the existing fleet and the age of the four engines. The maintenance costs were discussed as two of the engines have been out of service recently with large repairs. It was also discussed that depending on when a truck could be ordered, there was a proposed price increase coming in October. It was also noted that prepayment is another opportunity to lower cost of vehicle. Also, based on potential cost savings, a special called meeting could be an option.

Following discussion, council agreed to call a special meeting for Thursday, September 30 to consider approval of fire truck to take advantage of current pricing and to prepay for truck to save approximately 2% on overall cost of vehicle.

After general discussion, the meeting was duly adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
