The City of Pigeon Forge Fire Department is seeking to hire a **Full-Time Fire Inspector, Salary Pay Range \$47,424.00/yr - \$74,152.00/yr**. The city offers a highly competitive compensation and benefit package.

**JOB DESCRIPTION:** This is responsible protective service and investigative work assisting with the inspection of industrial, commercial, and other buildings and structures to determine compliance with existing fire and construction codes and investigating any fires in Pigeon Forge that result in property damage. Activities associated with the job include, but are not limited to:

- Performing fire inspections
- Presenting fire prevention programs
- Investigating fires that result in property damage and responding to complaints and/or reports of hazardous conditions.
- Reviewing plans for industrial, commercial and other buildings to determine compliance with fire prevention codes and fire detection and suppression devices.
- Investigating explosions, fires and hazardous material spills to determine the cause, origin and/or heat source.
- Conducting fire drills and training on fire hazards and prevention.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Graduation from an accredited high school; Firefighting experience or NFPA 1001 preferred; sufficient strength and agility to perform the physically demanding aspects of the job and operate all firefighting and emergency response equipment; strong decision making and interpersonal skills; knowledge of NFPA, OSHA, TOSHA and EPA regulations pertaining to fire fighting and hazardous materials; considerable training in conducting arson investigations; thorough knowledge of building and fire prevention codes; ability to respond to emergency situations in a timely and appropriate manner; valid driver's license is required.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:** -A minimum age of 21 years; U.S. citizen; Possession of a valid Driver's License from your state and the ability to obtain a Tennessee license; Must reside in State of Tennessee no further than 30 road miles from the Pigeon Forge Fire Station #1 or Fire Station #2 within 6 months hire; Cannot have been convicted or plead guilty, or entered a plea of nolo contendere to any felony charge or to any violation of any federal or state laws or city ordinances relating to force, violence, theft, dishonesty, gambling, liquor or controlled substances; Must maintain certification in CPR.
