Position Title: Lead Water Maintenance Technician, Full-Time

Job Description: This is very skilled technical work involving the operation repair of water pumping and purification equipment located in the water treatment plant for City of Pigeon Forge. Activities associated with the job include, but are not limited to:

- Inspects and does preventive and predicative maintenance as well as repairs on pump stations, intake
 and basins and installs mechanical, electromechanical, and associated equipment at plant and/or pump
 stations.
- Efficiently maintain, install, repair and calibrate all instruments and equipment which may include: pumps, valves, bearings, seals, gages, gearboxes, blowers, chemical feed, controls, gauges, and metering devices which may include electronic circuity, Variable frequency drives, soft starters, PLC's (programmable logic control units) and SCADA (Supervisory control and data acquisition). Systems and other sophisticated equipment.
- Diagnose problems (regardless of complexity), troubleshoot mechanical, electro-mechanical, and take corrective action within policy and procedure limitations.
- Performs routine equipment and grounds maintenance activities as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications: Graduation from an accredited four year high school; minimum of 5 years of experience in a service environment involving water treatment facilities with pump motor and controls background; considerable knowledge of the repair and maintenance of the mechanical, hydraulic and electrical components of water plants and pump stations; considerable knowledge of the occupational hazards and necessary safety precautions of the work; ability to read, write, and comprehend instructions and schematics; read, interpret, and record data from meters, gauges, scales, panels, computer consoles and other equipment; skill in the use of hand and power tools utilized in adjusting system and plant components; good organizational, interpersonal and decision making skills; Valid Tennessee Driver's license required.
