The City of Pigeon Forge, Tennessee is seeking to hire a **Traffic Maintenance Supervisor**. This position reports directly to the Street Superintendent.

Description: This is skilled technical and supervisory work overseeing semi-skilled and skilled work crews involving the maintenance, repair, and installation of traffic controllers and communication equipment, signage operations, and electrical needs for winterfest for the City of Pigeon Forge. Activities associated with the job involves the planning, coordination, and administration of all tasks associated with the installation, repair, modification, and maintenance of traffic system, intelligent Transportation System (ITS), and the associated communications systems. Activities associated with the job include operating all types of electrical and optical equipment. Additional activities with the job include operating all types of equipment used for road installation and repair including mowers, forklifts, bucket trucks, etc. Additional activities include installing special event decorations, lighting and bulbs, constructing, repairing and/or replacing new and existing electrical services and pumps and performing a variety of general labor tasks associated with road repair and maintenance.

Benefits: The City of Pigeon Forge offers a competitive benefit package to their full-time employees which includes paid medical/dental/vision insurance for individual and family coverage, life insurance, long-term disability, and Holiday. Upon hire, paid leave is offered according to policy for Vacation, Sick and Personal time. A retirement plan is also offered once eligibility is met.

Qualifications Graduation from an accredited four year high school and successful completion of electronics program from a CHEA accredited vocational or technical school or college and/or electrical apprenticeship; Completion of ZMSA level certifications; ten (10) years of experience in the maintenance repair, installation, and inspection of electronic traffic control devices, ITS and communications equipment; supervisor experience; experience working in highway maintenance operations; thorough experience in the electrical trades (preferably at a journeyman level), thorough knowledge of the occupational hazards and necessary safety precautions of the work; skill in the use of electrical and optical equipment utilized in working with traffic controllers and communication equipment; knowledge installing and maintaining directional traffic signs; ability to interact tactfully with the public; a valid TN Driver's License.
