The City of Pigeon Forge Department of Public Works is accepting applications for a **Full-Time Water Plant Operator, Starting Pay: \$19.00/hr.** The city offers a highly competitive compensation and benefit package.

**Job Description:** This is skilled technical work involving the operation of water pumping and purification equipment located in the water treatment plant for the City of Pigeon Forge. Activities associated with the job include, but are not limited to:

- Monitoring and adjusting plant and system operations through Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition
- Troubleshooting and maintaining plant and remote site equipment including pumps, motors, valves and controls
- Calibrating laboratory equipment and performing water quality tests
- Collecting and analyzing raw and finished water samples
- Conducting routine rounds to inspect and record plant conditions
- Working in accordance to rules established by Tennessee Department of Conservation, Division of Water Resources, Environmental Protection Agency and other regulatory standards

**Minimum Qualifications:** Graduation from an accredited four year high school supplemented with additional training and experience in water treatment plant operations; a Water Plant Operator III or IV license is preferred; some knowledge of the repair and maintenance of the mechanical, hydraulic and electrical components of water treatment plants preferred; knowledge of the occupational hazards and necessary safety precautions of the work; skill in the use of hand and power tools utilized in adjusting system and plant components; good organizational, interpersonal and decision making skills;; valid Tennessee Driver's License.
