## Scope of Work:

The following is the full scope of work for the demolition and removal of all structures on 529 Kings Hill Boulevard in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee.

Environmental Inspection for asbestos and lead done by a licensed and certified inspector. The existence, quantity, and location of any materials made from asbestos or lead are unknown to the city. Age suggest that it is unlikely either are present (built 1994).

Abatement and/or removal of any asbestos and lead (if necessary).
If present, all removal and disposal must meet all federal, state, and local requirements. The contractor is responsible for all notifications and fees for the asbestos removal, if necessary.

Demolition and removal of the 2800 square foot/two story main structure and 1200 square foot detached garage.

- This includes removal and disposal of all miscellaneous debris associated with both structures, all foundations, and slabs. The property is to be graded to a level condition.
- Includes removal and disposal of driveways and sidewalks on the property.

The Contractor shall be responsible for all utility disconnections.

Thorough documentation of all activities must be obtained and presented.

 This includes Waste Management Disposal Report Record Landfill Tickets.

Existing vegetation shall be protected from damage as much as possible, especially large trees.
