Indoor Kiddie Pool Renovation

The City of Pigeon Forge, Tennessee is seeking proposals to renovate their Kiddie Pool located in the Pigeon Forge Community Center's Indoor Pool. The City seeks to increase the indoor pool deck space while adding a fun and exciting feature to the pool area. This project is small in scale but will have a significant impact on the quality of the Indoor Pool Facility. The City envisions eliminating the current indoor kiddie pool and replacing it with a ground level spray pad with different spray features and a perimeter water collection system that is returned to a filtering system so the water can be treated and re-used.

Requirements for the Proposal

- Companies submitting a proposal are required to schedule a time to visit the site and obtain the information and proper measurements needed to determine what will be required to complete the project.
- Companies will be required to hold all licenses required in the State of Tennessee to do the work and accomplish the task.
- Companies must have at least five (5) years of experience performing swimming pool work with specific expertise in installing ground level spray features and splash pads for commercial/public usage.
- Spray features shall not exceed the water collections system and the surface shall match the existing deck surrounding the area. Inlaid aquatic images can be a part of the spray pad finish.
- Companies will be required to provide photos/examples of similar projects they have completed in the past along with at least three past customer as referrals.
- Work must be completed within six (6) months from the notice to proceed from the City.
- Proposals must include at least two (2) different designs but no more than five (5) with 2-D drawings depicting top and side views of what the spray patterns will be when completed.
- The layout of the plumbing/piping/control valve(s) proposed, and any electrical modifications required shall be included.

- Water purification systems must be a part of the project and meet all health and safety codes.
- Companies will be required to meet all insurance requirements and will be responsible for obtaining all building and health department permits requirements.
- This project has a maximum budget of \$375,000 to cover all the design and engineering work, permits, construction, and all other cost associated with this project.
